

Supplementary Seasonal Employment Work Visa

New Zealand Visa Information Checklist

Visa summary

For eligible people already in New Zealand on a student or visitor visa who want approved seasonal horticulture or viticulture work.

Length of stay: 6 months | Cost: NZD \$1355

General requirements

- ☐ be aged 18 or older
- ☐ already be in New Zealand on a visitor or student visa
- ☐ genuinely intend to do seasonal work for an approved employer
- ☐ have plans to leave New Zealand at the end of your stay
- ☐ meet the other requirements of this visa.
- ☐ plant, maintain, harvest or pack crops for an approved employer under the Supplementary Seasonal Employer Scheme (SSE)
- ☐ work in seasonal employment for up to 6 months
- ☐ study or train for up to 3 months in any 12-month period, in addition to any study or training that is authorised by your approved employer as part of your employment.
