

Trafficking Victim Resident Visa

New Zealand Visa Information Checklist

Visa summary

For eligible people in New Zealand who already hold a trafficking victim temporary visa and cannot safely return home.

Length of stay: Live, work and study indefinitely | Cost: NZD \$0 | Processing time: is a high priority

General requirements

- ☐ have a trafficking victim work, student or visitor visa
- ☐ be in New Zealand and unable to return home
- ☐ be certified as a victim of people trafficking by the New Zealand Police
- ☐ be certified by the New Zealand Police that you have not obstructed the investigation of your trafficking case
- ☐ meet the other requirements of this visa.
- ☐ live, work and study in New Zealand
- ☐ travel in and out of New Zealand until your travel conditions expire, 2 years from the date you first arrive in New Zealand as a resident.
