New Zealand Visa Information Checklist

Visa summary

For people in New Zealand who have been certified by New Zealand Police as suspected victims of people trafficking.

Length of stay: Stay for 12 months | Cost: NZD \$0 | Processing time: is a high priority

General requirements

- ☐ be in New Zealand
- ☐ show the New Zealand Police has certified you as a suspected victim of people trafficking
- ☐ meet the other requirements of this visa.
- ☐ work in almost any job for any employer in New Zealand
- ☐ study for up to 3 months in any 12-month period you may be able to do other study if it is required by your employer as part of your job
- ☐ apply for the Trafficking Victim Resident Visa.
